

ROTEPFOTE YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD 2014 FOR SCIENTIFIC CONGRESSES

The society RotePfote - Cancer Research for Pets aims at fostering scientific projects in the field of Comparative Medicine and developing new methods of treatments for pets with cancer.

RotePfote is convinced that young scientists and researchers working in the field of Comparative Medicine play a vital role in today's research and innovation while securing the further development of this topic. This is why RotePfote has launched the ROTEPFOTE YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD 2014 for junior scientists and researchers.

This award is aimed at graduate and undergraduate students as well as post-docs studying or working at an Austrian university or research institution. Applicants must be 35 years of age or below at the time of application and must have successfully submitted an abstract as the first author and have, as a consequence, been invited to give an oral presentation or present a poster at a national or international meeting or conference. Only abstracts accepted between September 1st 2013 and September 30th 2014 will be considered.

The ROTEPFOTE YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD 2014 amounts to EUR 1.000,— and will be awarded to the three best applications.
